

Resort Essentials

What to Wear

Club Atlantis is very informal. Casual or sports attire is appropriate all day and night. Everything is a bit outdoors, so you might bring one long sleeve shirt and/or pants. There are no formal nights or costume parties during the week, although our theme parties may inspire a simple outfit or two.

Laundry service is available for an additional charge.

What to Bring

Bring plenty of sunblock, bug repellent, and basic toiletries. Beach towels are provided. Cancun is a major tourist town with great shopping, and it's possible to find virtually anything there. If you're a major shopper, leave some room in your luggage.

If you are taking any medication, please make sure you bring them in their original containers to avoid delays getting in and out of the country. Mexican authorities have very strict rules and penalties regarding all drugs, prescription or otherwise.

Your Dollars, Their Pesos

Most prices in tourist areas of Cancun are in both U.S. dollars and Mexican pesos. Most stores and restaurants accept both, but tie prices to the dollar. The current rate of exchange is 12.5 pesos to 1 dollar. There is no need to change money prior to leaving.

At the resort, telephone and boutique charges can be signed directly to your room. This account may be settled at the end of the week with your Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Travelers Checks, or cash. Personal checks are not accepted.

The Weather

Average temperature in Cancun is about 87° during the day and 76° at night. It usually is dry during this season, but you never know.

The Water

The water throughout the resort is filtered, purified, and safe to drink. We recommend bottled water outside the resort.

Shuttle Services

Shuttles are available within the resort to take you throughout the property. Please check the shuttle schedule.

Transportation to Cancun

Taxis are readily available from the front desk. There is also a public bus service that runs the length of the Cancun strip.

Before You Leave

Travel Documentation

You must have a valid passport to enter Mexico, and no Visa is required for US or Canadian citizens. Visas may be required for residents of other countries. Remember, all documents are your responsibility.

Luggage Advice

You should check with your air carrier regarding baggage allowance as most now charge for checked luggage. Weight restrictions vary by carrier.

Please don't place any valuables in your checked luggage - carry them on. This is a standard precaution on all international flights.

Getting There

Arrive Early

You should arrive at least 2 hours prior to departure of any international flight, including flights with connections from the USA.

Transfers to the Resort

If you purchased transfers from Atlantis, you will be met by a Club Med representative immediately outside of Customs and escorted to your ground transportation. They will be holding an Atlantis/Club Med sign. You may have to wait a few minutes for additional passengers.

The resort is approximately 15 minutes from the Cancun airport.
